Welcome! We wish to provide you with excellent care during your time with us. These instructions will help you prepare for your procedure.

ONE WEEK BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY PROCEDURE

- All patients **MUST** complete a Patient Health History and a Medication History prior to your procedure.
 - You will receive a phone call from a nurse 1-3 days prior to your scheduled exam. This phone call is to obtain your health history and current medications. This conversation will take approximately 10-15 minutes to complete. If you are not available, a message will be left for you to return the call.
 - You may call one day before your procedure, after 1 PM, to receive your arrival time. Our number is <u>801-924-2878</u>. Our hours are 7 AM to 4 PM. We are closed weekends and holidays.
 - For pre-service questions relating to insurance verification and procedure estimates, please call <u>801-512-0464</u>.
- If you have advanced directives such as a living will, a special power of attorney, or a medical treatment plan, please bring a copy of these documents with you on the day of the procedure.
- Stop all GLP-1/SLGT2 medications. Discuss alternatives with your prescribing provider. If taking these medications, only clear liquids for 48 hours prior to surgery.

ONE DAY BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY PROCEDURE

- We will contact you **AFTER 1 PM** the day before your procedure to confirm the time of your appointment. If you received a start time from your physician's office, please disregard that start time and follow the instructions from Intermountain Surgery Center Alta View Endoscopy.
- If you are having a colonoscopy, please follow the instructions from your doctor to complete your bowel preparation. If you have not yet received the instructions for your bowel preparation, please call your physician.

DAY OF YOUR ENDOSCOPY PROCEDURE

- You **MUST** arrange for a responsible person to drive you home.
- If you are having a colonoscopy, DO NOT eat anything solid the day before your procedure or the day of your procedure.

- If you are having an upper Endoscopy, **DO NOT** eat anything solid the day of your procedure.
- You may drink **ONLY** water, apple juice, sports drinks (no red or purple), or soda pop until 2 hours before your arrival time at Intermountain Surgery Center – Alta View. Absolutely nothing by mouth 2 hours before your scheduled procedure time or your procedure may be cancelled. This includes water, gum, candy, mints and cigarettes.
- You may take specific medications, as directed by your physician, with a sip of water as early as possible. If you use an inhaler, please bring it with you as well as any other medications as directed by your physician.
- To enter Intermountain Surgery Center Alta View, enter the front door of the west side of building 1 of the Alta View Hospital campus.
- One family member should remain with you to receive instructions from the doctor after your procedure.
- Keep in mind there is limited space, and the wait can be very long for children.
- Do not wear jewelry, metal body piercings, or hair accessories. Please leave valuables at home.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing that is easy to get on and off.
- Due to the sedative medicine often used and for safety reasons, you are not allowed to drive yourself home. You must have a designated driver to take you home. If you use public transportation, you will need to have somebody accompany you home.
